## 1. POLICY STATEMENTS

- 1.1 This policy provides a formal structure for our working environment and helps ensure there is good environmental management throughout Risk Extraction MK, both at its own working environments and whilst working in its customer environments.
- 1.2 General Statement of Environmental policy:  
Risk Extraction MK is committed to complying with all applicable environmental legislation as well as learning about and applying best practices throughout its operations, wherever this is practicable. Furthermore, Risk Extraction MK seeks continuous improvement of our performance by setting objectives and targets to achieve environmental goals.
- 1.3 Risk Extraction MK conduct internal reviews to measure environmental performance and to ensure compliance with legislation and other requirements applicable to its organisation.

- Increasing use of more readily biodegradable alternatives to hazardous chemicals, materials and substances, that are or have less adverse impact on the environment.
  - Reducing landfill through reducing consumption and increasing recycling, of stationary, packaging and office consumables.
  - Training staff and contractors in environmental awareness and environmental management systems.
  - Using the best practicable and available techniques to reduce emissions and to minimise the risk of uncontrolled accidental release into the environment.
- 1.5 Risk Extraction MK will do its best to promote to its customers environmental awareness, and where practicable, actively encourage them to adopt best environmental practice.
- 1.6 Through its selection and operational processes, Risk Extraction MK shall seek to influence and encourage its contractors and key suppliers to help them adopt best practice and in turn, reduce their impact on the environment.



- 1.7 This policy will be implemented through the management processes and structure of Risk Extraction MK. Andrew Hale has overall responsibility for this policy.
- 1.8 This policy statement will be reviewed and updated annually, to reflect improved environmental awareness and any changing legislation.
